

Girls win the final!!!

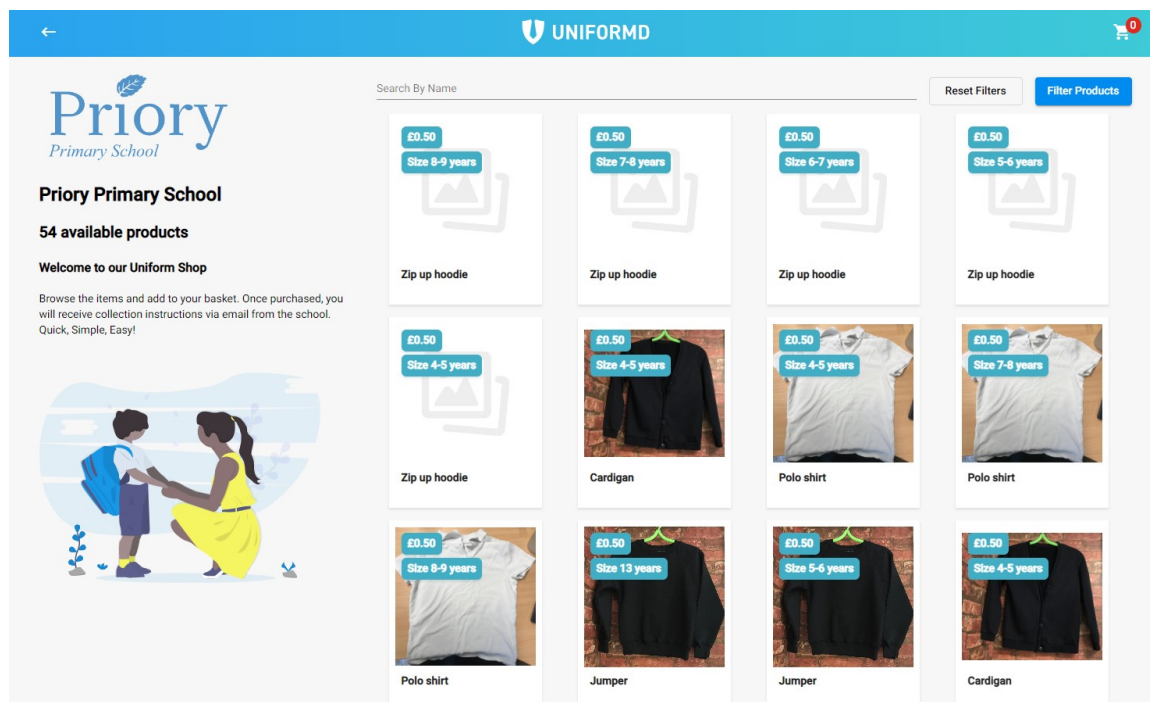

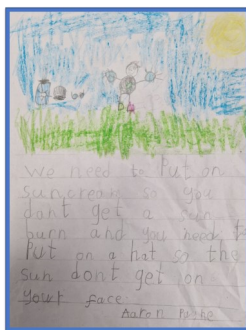


Priory JLT (Junior Leadership team)

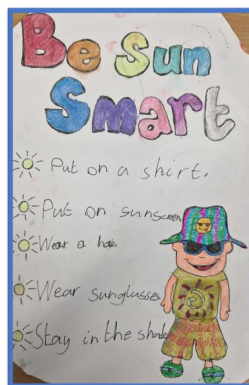

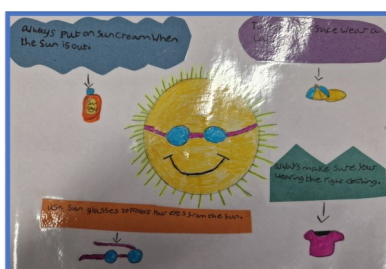

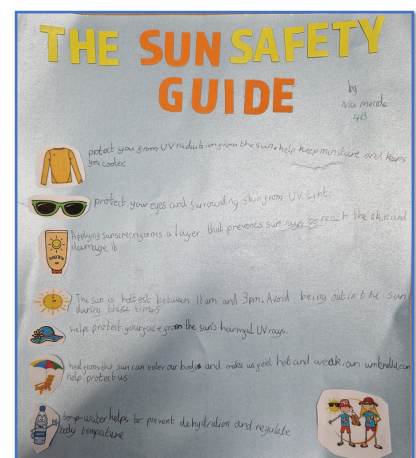
