Currently, 5K are in first place across all of our classes with an attendance of 93.84%

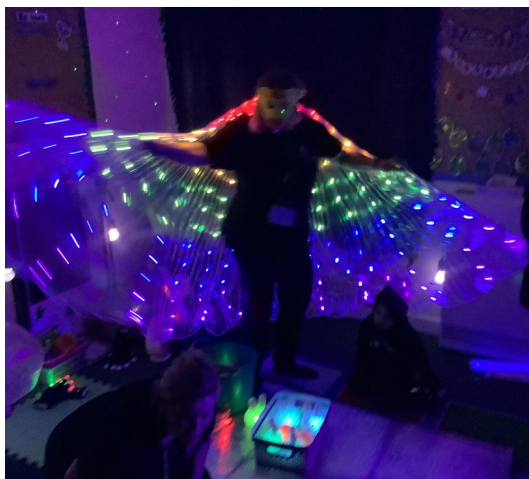


## ANCIENT EGYPTIAN JEWELLERY
